

Accommodation for the 2026/2027 academic year

The allocation of places in SGGW dormitories for the 2026/2027 academic year, as part of the centralised allocation procedure, takes place in two stages:

Step 1 – submitting an application for a place for the 2026/2027 academic year (current SGGW students by 15 August – via eHMS; SGGW candidate students admitted by 14 August 2026 – on paper at the ADiSS office)

Step 2 – online accommodation booking and accommodation dates via eHMS; all students (current SGGW students, SGGW candidates) – via eHMS in September, on different, separate dates for students, candidates. During the online booking process, students will be able to choose from all SGGW dormitories, whilst candidates and exchange students will be able to choose from ZDS-2, ZDS-3, ZDS-4, and ZDS-5 facilities.

The specific booking dates will be announced in early September 2026.

In the 2026/2027 academic year, all rooms in ZDS-1 – Oaza, ZDS-2, ZDS-3, ZDS-4 and ZDS-5 will be allocated under a 'spaced-out' system, meaning double rooms for single occupancy and triple rooms for two people. The Limba dormitory will offer twin rooms for two people, whilst the Krokus dormitory will offer single rooms only.

Check-in for SGGW students, students applying to study at SGGW, and students on SGGW exchange programmes who have been allocated places at the dormitories for the 2026/2027 academic year as part of the collective allocation procedure will take place on 28, 29 and 30 September, exclusively between 8.00 and 16.00 Polish time.

Accommodation for SGGW students, students applying to study at SGGW, and students on SGGW exchange programmes who, for various reasons, do not submit applications for accommodation as part of the collective allocation procedure for the 2026/2027 academic year will be able to apply for a place in the dormitory by submitting an individual application for additional accommodation from 1 October 2026.
